TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION

1.0. GENERAL

Mormugao Port Trust invites a quotation for the work of “Re-routing of Hospital Optical Fibre Cable”.

2.0. SCOPE OF WORK

2.1 The Port Hospital gets its network link through OFC from Port’s Data Center through Civil-Headland Office. The new OFC shall be laid from Civil- Headland office to Hospital gate through HDPE pipe.

2.2 The HDPE pipe along with OFC shall be laid underground and partially the balance OFC cable clamped suitably on to the Port Colony compound wall as directed by the Port Engineer.

2.3 The trench of 60cms depth and width 40cm width shall be excavated at Civil-Headland office and at motorable road gates. HDPE pipe with OFC shall be laid at the bottom of the trench and then backfilled. The excavation shall be done manually. Any damage to the other cables or pipes during excavation/ execution of works has to be rectified by contractor free of cost.

2.4 The OFC (make: D-Link or AMP) has to be supplied by the contractor as per BOQ. HDPE pipe will be supplied by the Port. However, the HDPE pipe has to be collected by the contractor from MM stores at Baina, Vasco by making arrangement for transportation at their own cost and safely unload at site.

2.5 After splicing the OFC at both ends, all the cores have to be tested for network connectivity by the contractor

2.1. INSTALLATION AND COMMISSIONING

The Re-routing of Hospital Optical Fibre Cable shall be done by making necessary arrangement with requisite tools and devices/instrumentation which are to be made available by the contractor at the site as directed by Port Engineer.

3.0. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

3.1. Validity:

The validity period for the offer shall be 60 days from the date of opening of the quotation.

3.2. Price:

The evaluation shall be based upon on the basic price. The rates offered shall be exclusive of GST. If any new tax imposed by the State/Central Govt., same shall be reimbursed by producing documentary proof.

3.3. Performance Guarantee:

5% of contract value will be deducted from the bill and will be retained as Performance Guarantee and released after satisfactory and successful commissioning completion of guarantee period.

3.4. Completion Period:

The entire work shall be completed within 4 **weeks** from day of issue of LOA/PO.

3.5. Guarantee Period:

The Contractor shall guarantee the work for a period of **1 year** from the date of taking over and successful commissioning of the work. Any defect observed during the guarantee period, the same shall be rectified by the Contractor, free of cost.

3.6. Payment Terms:

- i. 95% payment shall be made within 15 days after satisfactory completion and successful commissioning of work on producing invoice complete in all respects.
- ii. Balance 5% will be retained as Performance Guarantee and will be released after successful completion of guarantee period.
- iii. The contractor shall furnish their bank account details for the payment through ECS by the Trust. A copy of the PAN card, Service Tax Registration no., EPF& ESI shall be furnished. MICR number Name of the Branch along with Bill for arranging payment made through E.C.S. by the Trust.

3.7. Liquidated Damages:

In the event of failure by the contractor to complete the execution of the work within the time stipulated in the contract or by the expiry of any period of extension granted by the Board's terms thereof, the contractor shall pay the Board as Liquidated Damages for delay to complete the work, a sum of 0.5% of contract price per week or part thereof subject to a maximum of 5% and the Board shall have the power to deduct this amount from the payment of the amounts due to the contractor.

3.8. Other terms and conditions

- i) All tools and tackles shall be arranged by the Contractor at their own cost.
- ii) The Bidders are advised to visit the site and get acquainted with the site and quantum of the work involved before quoting rates for the work.

- iii) The technical specification Schedule 'A' and Schedule of prices and quantities Schedule 'A1' to be read in conjunction to ensure the actual supply and works involved.
- iv) Necessary Harbour Entry Permits shall be obtained by the Contractor at their own cost with the approval of Port Officials.
- v) The Trust will not be responsible for any loss or damage of the men/materials/tools/plants engaged by the firm during the work at site or transportation. The Contractor shall comply with the Dock Safety in practice at the Port
- vi) The Contractor shall take utmost care during the execution of the work, if any damage to Port property, the cost of the damage shall be deducted from the Contractor's bill as the case may be or recovered from the Contractor by the Board.
- vii) The contractor shall envisage quantum of the work involved which have not been specifically mentioned in the BOQ, but which are found necessary for overall completion of the works without incurring any additional expenditure to the Port.
